

## Greet Vermeylen



### Biography

Greet Vermeylen is research manager in the working conditions and industrial relations unit in the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions (Eurofound) since 2003. She is working on the European Working Conditions Survey (EWCS). The EWCS is a European-wide survey of workers, taking place roughly every 5 years, and dealing with a wide variety of aspects related to working conditions. Greet is the project leader of the European Company Survey. This is a European-wide survey of managers and employee representatives. The topic of the survey changes over time. The last wave took place in 2013 and dealt with work organisation, workplace innovation, employee participation and social dialogue in establishments with 10 employees or more. Throughout her time in Eurofound, she has been working on many aspects of working conditions, for instance related to working time, work-life balance, work organisation, etc. Apart from the work on the surveys and their spin-offs, she has been involved in a number of other projects such as the network of European observatories (European Working Conditions Observatory), projects on working poor, flexicurity and case studies on attractive workplaces for all.

She previously worked in the European Commission (DG Employment and Social Affairs) and a Belgian Presidency Taskforce for the Presidency of the European Union dealing with social protection issues. She is a Belgian national.
